Dear Plymouth Community Members,

The Town of Plymouth invites you to participate in an upcoming meeting regarding a proposed modification to where treated effluent from the Town's Wastewater Treatment Plant is discharged.

This project proposes transitioning the primary discharge of treated wastewater from the current outfall in Plymouth Harbor to the on-site infiltration beds at the Treatment Plant located at 131 Camelot Drive, while increasing the total allowable permitted discharge from 2.5 million gallons per day up to 3.0 million gallons per day. These improvements are part of the Town's efforts to modernize infrastructure and support long-term sustainability. The proposed change is being undertaken in order to improve water quality in the Harbor, with associated benefits to ecology, commercial aquaculture, and recreation.

The Town recognizes that the proposed increase in flow to the onsite infiltration beds is significant for local water resources and requires evaluation of its benefits and impacts. For that reason, the project is undergoing thorough review under the Massachusetts Environmental Policy Act (MEPA), and careful consideration is being given to potential impacts on groundwater, surrounding ecosystems, and community health.

We also recognize the importance of environmental justice and are committed to ensuring that all communities have a meaningful opportunity to participate in this process. Your input will help guide responsible decision-making and ensure that outcomes reflect community priorities.
